

Carlisle Elementary School's INSPIRE Art Contest



Carlisle Elementary is holding an art contest and entries are due by March 15, 2019. All participants will have their artwork displayed at Carlisle until releasing for Spring Break.

A panel of judges will choose 15 entries from the school to enter into the Marshall Medical Center INSPIRE youth art contest. Students from schools in the surrounding area will be entered into the INSPIRE contest. There will be winners chosen in each division and the school will be notified on April 8th if any Carlisle Elementary students placed. Any winner from the Marshall Medical Center contest will be invited to attend an award's reception. More details will be provided if Carlisle Elementary has any students place. - Students in Kingergarten-5th Grade may enter.

Categories:

Paintings: oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.

Drawings: pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink

Required Size:

Artwork in not required to be matted, but a mat is suggested. No framed or stretched canvas will be accepted.

- If artwork is matted, the size (including mat) may not exceed 20" x 20"
 - If the artwork is NOT matted, the size may not exceed 18" x 18"
- There is no specific theme for the art contest, however, art should reflect the title of the contest: INSPIRE. In 2013, Marshall Medical Centers opened its new Cancer Care Center for all of Marshall County so the art chosen this year will again reflect the theme of inspiration and hope for the patients.
- All artwork must be an original design and work of the student. No copies, clipart, computer generated or enhanced artwork will be allowed.
